ORANGEBURG PREPARATORY SCHOOLS, INC., is an independent, college-preparatory, coeducational day school enrolling students in preschool through twelfth grade. Orangeburg Prep is accredited by Cognia and the South Carolina Independent School Association (SCISA). The school's other affiliations include the Southern Association in Independent Schools (SAIS), the National Association of Secondary School Principals (NASSP), and the Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development (ASCD).

AP (ADVANCED PLACEMENT) COURSES OFFERED: AP Biology, AP Calculus, AP Human Geography, AP U.S. History

DUAL CREDIT: Students have an opportunity to receive up to 20 hours of dual credit classes through O-C Tech and Troy University.

ORANGEBURG PREP HIGHLIGHTS: 514 students in Pre K through 12th grades, approximately eighty-two faculty and staff, Child Development Center, Student Center (peer tutoring program), forty athletic teams, two campuses, two gyms, two libraries, award-winning Fine Arts Department, academic clubs, civic clubs, special interests clubs, speech / resource services, and STEPS Program.

STEPS PROGRAM: The STEPS (Students Thinking Exploring Practicing Succeeding) Program is a school intervention program that identifies students' needs and provides additional instruction. The goal of the STEPS Program is to identify and cultivate students who have varying learning needs and could benefit from different levels of instruction. Learning support assists students in maintaining and developing into successful and independent learners with positive self-advocacy skills. STEPS is an assessment based and referral program. Individualized goals and strategies will be developed to assist students in meeting his/her academic potential.

Class of 2023 Facts & Comparisons

CLASS OF 2023: The twenty-eight graduating seniors of the Class of 2023 perpetuate Orangeburg Prep's legacy of academic excellence. **Six** students are being recognized by the South Carolina Independent School Association as SCISA Honor Graduates for having scored at least 1100 on the SAT or 24 on the ACT while obtaining a 3.5 grade point average for each of seven semesters. **Eighteen** students are graduating with high honors which mean they have a cumulative grade point average of 4.0 or higher, while **six** students earned Life Scholarship.

Furthermore, Orangeburg Prep had **two** students receiving the Palmetto Fellows Award. To receive the Palmetto a student must score at least 1200 on the SAT or 25 on the ACT, earn a cumulative 3.5 GPA, and rank in the top six percent of their class. A student who is not in the top six percent of his/her class may earn the Palmetto by scoring either 1400 on the SAT or 31 on the ACT and earn a cumulative 4.0 GPA. Among colleges and universities that our graduates will attend are Clafin University Clemson University, Clemson Bridge Program, Francis Marion University, Lander University, Midlands Technical College, Newberry College, Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College, Presbyterian University, The Citadel, Trident Technical University, University of South Carolina, and Wofford College.
